

WEEK #2 of the Stay at Home Stitch Along Mystery Quilt

****SQUARES (2ND COMPONENT) & SNOWBALLS (3RD COMPONENT) ****

CUTTING – based on Fat Quarters (18' x 21')

From the Light (background) –

Select the 21 @ 3 ½" x 21"

- Cut 124 @ 3 ½" x 3 ½" – Label "**2nd component**"

Select 13 of the 2" x 21"

- Cut 124 @ 2" x 2"
 - Draw a line corner to corner on the wrong side of the square



From the Dark –

From the 12 strips cut @ 3 ½" x 21"

- Cut 63 @ 3 ½" x 3 ½"
 - Select 31 to be used to make "SNOWBALLS".
 - Set the remaining 32 aside for later....



Snowballs - 3rd component

Refer to the photo and follow the 4 steps to make Snowballs using the Light 2" squares and the 3 ½" Darks.

#1 place a 2" x 2" square on the corner of the Dark 3 ½" x 3 ½" square.... right sides together.

- Stitch on the line.

#2 press to the light.

- Cut excess (1/4" seam allowance)

#3 place a 2" x 2" square on the remaining corners

- Stitch on the line

#4 press to the light

- Cut excess (1/4" seam allowance)
- Trim to 3 ½" x 3 ½"
- Make 31 and label "**3rd component**"
