

WEEK #4 of the Stay at Home Stitch Along Mystery Quilt

**Snowballs with "medium corners" (5th COMPONENT) &
Stitching #1 and #2 components together = (6th COMPONENT) **

Alright...let's make some more of those "Snowballs". This time we will use the 32 Dark squares (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") that you cut in week #2 and the Medium squares (2" x 2") that you will cut now. Repeat the same steps (see below) to make 32 Snowballs.

We will also start joining some of the components that we have made....pay attention to the TOTAL that need to be made – you will have left-over parts! Don't worry!

From the MEDIUM –

Select the 13 @ 2" x 21"

- Cut 124 @ 2" x 2"
 - Draw a line corner to corner on the wrong side of the square

From the Dark – cut during Week #2

- Select the remaining 32 @ 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".



Snowballs - 5th component

Refer to the photo (this shows the "Light" 2" squares...you will use the "medium" 2" squares to make this batch of Snowballs) and follow the 4 steps to make Snowballs using the MEDIUM 2" squares and the 3 1/2" Darks.

#1 - place a 2" x 2" square on the corner of the Dark 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square.... right sides together.

- Stitch on the line.

#2 - press to the Medium.

- Cut excess (1/4" seam allowance)

#3 - place a 2" x 2" square on the remaining corners

- Stitch on the line

#4 - press to the Medium

- Cut excess (1/4" seam allowance)
- Trim to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- Make 32 and label "5th component"



Joining Component #1 and #2 to make 31 Component #6

Take one solid 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" (component #2) and one Half Square Triangle (component #1) and sew together following the layout in the photo. Press to the solid square. Make only 31.
