

WEEK #6 of the Stay at Home Stitch Along Mystery Quilt

****Sewing all of those Components together!!!****

“A” Units – need the 31 “Component #6” from Week #4, the remaining 93 Half Square Triangles, and 31 solid 3 ½” x 3 ½” squares.

- Using the 31 solid squares and 31 HST make so more of the “Component #6”
 - Press to the solid
- Refer to photo and sew remaining HST to the “Component #6”
 - Press to the solid
 - Make 62



“B” Units – need 64 “Component #7”- Triangle in a Square, and 128 “Component #4”- Four-Patch.

- Refer to photo and lay out the four-patch and Triangle in a Square block...confirming the correct placement of the four-patch – then..
- sew a four-patch on either side of the Triangle in a Square block.
 - Press to the four-patch
 - Make 64



“C” Units – need the 62 “Component #2” –solid squares and 31 “Component #3”- Snowballs (square in a square) from Week #2.

- Refer to the photo and sew a solid square on both sides of the Snowball/ Square in a Square block.

TIP- when you sew the two together... place the “pieced” block on top so you will be able to see the tip/intersection. You won’t lose your points!.

- Press to the solid square.
- Make 31



“D” Units – need 64 Triangle in a Square and 32 “Component 5” Snowballs (square in a square) from week 4.

- Refer to the photo and sew a “triangle” on both sides of the “snowball”.

TIP- before you stitch the two pieces together..peek inside the “seam allowance” edge to make sure that the tips of the triangles are lined up and even.

- Press to the center.
- Make 32
