

# WEEK #7 of the Stay at Home Stitch Along Mystery Quilt

## Let's make some BLOCKS !!!

### "Snowball block"

You will need the 62 "A" Units and 31 "C" units you made in Week #6.

- You will sew an "A" Unit on both sides of the "C" Units.
- The seams will nest together to make this easy.
- Press the seams to the center square.
- Make 31 blocks.
- Trim  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ "



### "Star block"

You will need the 32 - "B" Units and 64- "D" Units you made in week 6.

- You will sew a "B" unit on both sides of the "D" unit.
- The seams will nest together to make this easy.
- Press the seams away from center
- Make 32
- Trim  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ' x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ "



TIPS – pin the seams where they nest. Line up the tips and pin in place. Stitch.



Pressing TIPS – set seams with hot iron...while still warm “finger press” the seam open. Press well.



Keep on stitching!
